EXISTING BYLAW:

4.10 Terms – The President will serve a four year term, the Treasurer and High Performance Director will serve three year terms and the Secretary and Member at Large will serve two year terms. Elected Directors will hold office until their successors have been duly elected in accordance with these Bylaws, unless they resign, are removed from or vacate their office. Directors will be eligible for re-election as Directors.
